VENTURA COUNTY AGRICULTURAL COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE SUMMARY OF HEMP COMPLAINTS RECEIVED

The VCAC Hemp Comment Mailbox received over 250 responses:

Approximately 17.5% were in support of hemp, with approximately 82.5% against.

In addition to the VCAC Hemp mailbox, the VCAC received hundreds of phone calls, emails and in-person visits by citizens from all points of view, including prospective growers and processors of hemp, pest control operators, and concerned neighbors, especially from Moorpark and Camarillo, but also from Fillmore, Ojai, Ventura and CA State University, Channel Islands. Comments were submitted by cities, including Camarillo, Moorpark, Thousand Oaks and Santa Paula and by groups representing growers and others involved in hemp production. One letter was submitted on behalf of a Moorpark residential community.
