CAPCA is a professional organization of licensed agriculture and horticulture pest control advisers. This scholarship is intended to benefit students participating in the Pathway to PCA program or a career in plant science.

SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION:

Ventura CAPCA will give a **\$1000.00** scholarship to a Ventura or Santa Barbara County resident enrolled in a 4-year California College or University, preferably majoring in Plant Science or Agriculture. Those participating in the Pathway to PCA Program will get higher priority.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Must be attending the college or university by **2022**.
2. Must have been a permanent resident of Ventura or Santa Barbara County prior to attending college.
3. Must present two letters of recommendation; one must be from a faculty member.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

1. GPA - 2.5 GPA or better. Include copy of transcripts.
2. Involvement in Ag related or community extracurricular activities.
3. Demonstrate an interest in plant science.
4. This scholarship will **not** be awarded to the recipient of either the Stanley W. Strew Education Fund or the Thomas C. Griffin Memorial Scholarship in the same year.

2. Applications must be submitted by **August 1st, 2021**. The two letters of recommendation (from teachers, advisers, employers, mentors, etc.) plus a copy of your transcripts can follow. Letters of recommendation from relatives are not acceptable.
3. The entire packet including transcripts and letters of recommendation must be received by **September 1st, 2021** or the application will not be considered.

Applications are due August 1st, 2021. The complete packet including transcript copies and letters of recommendation must be received by September 1st, 2021.

SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION:

Ventura CAPCA will give a **\$500.00** scholarship to a Ventura or Santa Barbara County resident attending Community College offering studies in the field of agriculture or horticulture.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Must live in Ventura or S.B County.
2. A recommendation from at least one faculty member.
3. Students will be transferring to a 4-year university by **2022**.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

1. GPA of 2.5 or better.
2. Involvement in extracurricular activities – preferably agriculture related.
3. Demonstrate an interest in becoming a pest control advisor (PCA) or work in the field of plant science or agriculture.

3. **The application must be received by August 1st, 2021. Complete packets including transcripts and letters of recommendation must be received by September 1st, 2021. Only complete packets will be considered.**
