CALL TO ORDER & ROLL CALL

At 1:02 P.M., Judge Hintz called the meeting of the Ventura County Treasury Oversight Committee ("TOC") to order, introductions were made, and attendance was taken.

AGENDA REVIEW & APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES FOR APRIL 14, 2021

Judge Hintz presented for addition to the TOC Agenda the 11/3/2021 Daily Snapshot, the 10/27/2021 and 10/28/2021 Investment Purchase Orders, the 11/1/2021 Analysis of Secured Property Tax Collections Report, and the 11/3/2021 Bloomberg graph.

Motion: Review, Receive & File five (5) additional documents to the TOC Agenda

The Committee briefly reviewed the five (5) additional documents and approved the Receive and File to add the five (5) additional documents to the Agenda.

COMMITTEE MEMBERS' AND STAFF COMMENTS

Treasurer-Tax Collector, Judge Steven Hintz, provided an Investment Pool summary:

- The pool investments increase monthly
- October 2021 was the largest month so far
- No new pool members added in the last 6 months
- \$65 Million received to the pool from the Sheriff's Office (FEMA) last week
- Lowest yield in several years
- Interest rate market is rising
- The investment pool has outperformed its three (3) benchmarks
- Standard and Poor's conducted their due diligence meeting on September 20, 2021
 - o S&P confirmation ratings letter to be received December 2021
- Judge Hintz and Misty Key discussed the appropriations of cash, the impacts of extra money on the County School's pool balance, and diminishing appropriations in November
- Biggest source of pool investments are property tax payments

AGENDA ITEM 6

Approve the Annual Treasury Oversight Committee Audit Engagement Letter with Brown Armstrong, dated May 5, 2021.

Judge Hintz discussed the various audits, including the Auditor-Controller's annual outside audit process, the Auditor-Controller's monthly review of Treasury investment reports, the annual Standard and Poor's due diligence meeting, and the various monthly and annual audits conducted with the County's Treasury Division.

AGENDA ITEM 7

Receive and File the August 31, 2021 Investment Report Presentation, approved by the Ventura County Board of Supervisors on October 19, 2021.

The TOC reviewed the August 31, 2021 investment report. Judge Hintz mentioned to the TOC Members that additional information can be added to the report by request. The Treasury plans to seek out new benchmarks over the next few months.

Ms. Key pointed out the negative \$5,060,093.28 balance on page 27. Judge Hintz and Marilou Tan reiterated that the number is an unrealized loss, which results from the accounting requirement that the portfolio be presented at market value. Since ours is a "buy and hold" portfolio, at maturity, there will be no realized losses.

Judge Hintz also mentioned that due to the retirement of the Sungard internal accounting system, we have transitioned to the Sympro internal accounting system.

Judge Hintz also discussed that since our current custodian, Wells Fargo Bank, has sold their custodial business, next year we will transition to The Principal Financial Group, as custodian.

Judge Hintz reviewed the Authorized Issuers List with the Treasury Oversight Committee. He discussed that the Investment Work Group (IWG) publishes the approved list monthly to the broker dealers. The Chief Financial Officer only buys from the approved issuers on the list. The IWG reviews the S&P points daily and adds/subtracts items from the Authorized Issuers List based on current ratings.

Judge Hintz explained the Treasurer-Tax Collector's annual request to the Board of Supervisors to renew the delegation of authority for the Treasurer-Tax Collector to manage the County's investment pool. The Auditor-Controller recommends this request annually.
