1. CALL TO ORDER

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Minutes of the October 17, 2022, PAC meeting were approved. All in favor.

5. NEW BUSINESS (Items A, B, & C from agenda approved to move before OLD BUSINESS)

A. New Supervisors Jeff Gorell District 2 and Janice Parvin District 4

B. Itinio – Reservation System Update
